17 To approve, on an emergency basis, Contract No. DCAM-19-CS-IFB-0010, between the
18 Department of General Services and Dissen & Juhn, LLC, increasing the aggregate
19 not-to-exceed amount of the Contract to \$1,013,562.00 and authorizing payment to
20 Dissen & Juhn, LLC for goods and services received and to be received under the
21 Contract.

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA,

24 That this act may be cited as the “Contract No. DCAM-19-CS-IFB-0010 with Dissen &
25 Juhn, LLC Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Act of 2020”.

26 Sec. 2. Pursuant to section 451 of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act,
27 approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 803; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.51) and the
28 requirements of section 202 of the Procurement Practices Reform Act of 2010, as
29 amended, effective April 8, 2011 (D.C. Law 18-371; D.C. Official Code § 2-352.02), the
30 Council approves, on an emergency basis, Contract No. DCAM-19-CS-IFB-0010
31 between the Department of General Services and Dissen & Juhn, LLC, increasing the
32 aggregate not-to-exceed amount of the Contract to \$1,013,562.00 and authorizing
33 payment to Dissen & Juhn, LLC for goods and services received and to be received under
34 the Contract.

1 Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement.

2 The Council adopts the fiscal statement of the Chief Financial Officer as the fiscal
3 impact statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of
4 1975, approved October 6, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).

5 Sec. 4. Effective date.

6 This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto
7 by the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), and shall remain in effect for
8 no longer than 90 days, as provided for emergency acts of the Council of the District of
9 Columbia in section 412(a) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved
10 December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 788; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.12(a)).
