35	related deaths, as those terms are defined in section 2(4) and (5) of the Maternal Mortality Review
36	Committee Establishment Act of 2018, effective June 5, 2018 (D.C. Law 22-111; D.C. Official
37	Code § 7-671.01(4) and (5)), and deaths resulting from severe maternal morbidity.
38	"(2) "Severe maternal morbidity" means one of the following outcomes of labor
39	and delivery that results in short-term or long-term consequences to a woman's health:
40	"(A) Acute myocardial infarction;
41	"(B) Acute renal failure;
42	"(C) Adult respiratory distress syndrome;
43	"(D) Air and thrombotic embolism;
44	"(E) Amniotic fluid embolism;
45	"(F) Anesthesia complications;
46	"(G) Aneurysm;
47	"(H) Blood products transfusion;
48	"(I) Cardiac arrest/ventricular fibrillation;
49	"(J) Conversion of cardiac rhythm;
50	"(K) Disseminated intravascular coagulation;
51	"(L) Eclampsia;
52	"(M) Heart failure/arrest during surgery or procedure;
