1 WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on November 7, 1973, concerning
2 the proposed closing of part of public alleys and setting land aside for public
3 alleys in Square 2806, as shown on a plat on file in the Office of the Surveyor
4 of the District of Columbia (S. O. 73-7); and

22 by advertisement and shall serve a copy of such order to each property owner
23 abutting said alley areas to be closed, in accordance with provisions of Section
24 7-404 of the D. C. Code, 1967 ed.

27 within thirty (30) days after the service of such order, the Surveyor shall record
28 in his office the said order and appropriate plat or plats.



Councilman Jerry A. Moore, Jr. Presents the following Resolution:

1 WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on November 7, 1973, concerning the
 2 closing of part of public alleys in Square 457, as shown on a plat on file in the Office
 3 of the Surveyor of the District of Columbia (S. O. 72-276); and
 4
 5 WHEREAS, the Public Space Committee has recommended (1) that title to the
 6 land embraced within the proposed closing shall revert to or vest in the applicant
 7 WITH COST; (2) that the applicant shall pay into the Treasury of the United States
 8 the sum of \$84,656.40, representing the estimated fair market value of the area to
 9 be closed as determined by the D. C. Department of Finance and Revenue; (3) that
 10 the applicant shall pay into the Highway Fund the sum of \$115.65, representing the
 11 current depreciated economic value of improvements within the area to be closed,
 12 minus assessments levied to date against the abutting property; (4) that the applicant
 13 agrees to leave unobstructed the subject alley once it is officially closed until such
 14 time as the buildings at 608-610 E Street, N. W. are demolished; (5) that an easement
 15 be established, 16-foot wide, centered on the centerline of the north-south alley
 16 proposed to be closed, and running the full length of this alley; and (6) that once the
 17 existing building at 608-610 E Street, N. W. has been razed, the easement shall be
 18 abolished and the sewer abandoned at the expense of the applicant; and

1 WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on November 7, 1973, concerning
2 the proposed closing of part of 33rd Place, S. E., as shown on a plat on file
3 in the Office of the Surveyor of the District of Columbia (S. O. 72-301); and

5 WHEREAS, the District of Columbia Council having considered the
6 proposed closing is of the opinion that said part of street should be closed.

8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the District of Columbia Council
9 that:

10 Section 1. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 7-401 through 7-410
11 of the District of Columbia Code and Section 402 (168) of Reorganization Plan
12 No. 3 of 1967, the street area as shown on the plat filed in the Office of the
13 Surveyor of the District of Columbia (S. O. 72-301) is hereby ordered closed.

16 Section 2. The Surveyor shall cause public notice of the order to
17 be given by advertisement and shall serve a copy of such order to each property
18 owner abutting the said part of street to be closed in accordance with the
19 provisions of Section 7-404 of the D. C. Code, 1967 ed.

21 Section 3. If no objection, in writing, is made by any party interested
22 within thirty (30) days after the service of such order, the Surveyor shall record
23 in his office the said order and the appropriate plat or plats.

25 Section 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
