15	To declare the existence of an emergency, due to congressional review, with respect to the need
16 17	to require that the District Department of Transportation publish a report identifying modifications to roadways in each ward that will create space for uses other than for
18	motorized vehicles and to set a timeline for implementation.

20	RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this
21	resolution may be cited as the "Connected Transportation Network Congressional Review
22	Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2020".
23	Sec. 2. (a) On June 9, 2020, the Council passed the Connected Transportation Network
24	Emergency Amendment Act of 2020, effective July 7, 2020 (D.C. Act 23-331; 67 DCR 8607)
25	("emergency act"), which expires on October 4, 2020.
26	(b) On July 7, 2020, the Council passed the Connected Transportation Network Temporary
27	Amendment Act of 2020, enacted on July 27, 2020 (D.C. Act 23-349; 67 DCR 9400) ("temporary
28	act"), which is undergoing congressional review and is projected to take effect November 16, 2020.
29	(c) This emergency legislation is necessary to prevent a gap in the law between the
30	expiration of the emergency act and the effective date of the temporary act.
31	Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the circumstances
32	enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that the

- 34 after a single reading.
- 35 Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
