A PROPOSED RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To declare an emergency with respect to the need to require the Department of Insurance, Securities and Banking to provide for the licensing of certain entities providing appraisal management services in the District of Columbia and to require an annual registration fee to be paid.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the "Appraisal Management Company Regulation Congressional Review Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2020".

Sec. 2. (a) On July 7, 2020, the Council passed the Appraisal Management Company Regulation Emergency Act of 2020, effective July 27, 2020 (D.C. Act 23-341; 7 DCR 9357) which expires on October 24, 2020.

(b) On July 21, 2020, the Council passed the Appraisal Management Company Regulation Temporary Act of 2020 (D.C. Act 23-392; 67 DCR 9891) ("temporary act"), which is set to become law on November 16, 2020.

(c) This identical second round of emergency legislation is necessary to prevent a gap in the law between the expiration of the emergency act and the effective date of the temporary measure.

Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the circumstances

enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that the
"Appraisal Management Company Regulation Congressional Review Emergency Act of 2020"
be adopted after a single reading.
Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
