SUBJECT: Requests for the October 6, 2020 Legislative Meeting

I request that the following emergency measures be agendized for the October 6th Legislative Meeting:

- RPP Voluntary Exclusion Congressional Review Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2020
- RPP Voluntary Exclusion Congressional Review Emergency Act of 2020

On July 21st, the Council passed the RPP Voluntary Exclusion Emergency Act of 2020; that emergency legislation will expire on November 11, 2020. On September 22, 2020, the Council passed the RPP Voluntary Exclusion Temporary Act of 2020, which is undergoing mayoral review; as such, the temporary act will not be effective when the emergency act expires. This emergency legislation is necessary to prevent a gap in the law between the expiration of the emergency act and the effective date of the temporary act.

The emergency legislation would provide the Mayor with authority to make a property ineligible for residential parking permits where such ineligibility is a condition of a zoning order.

On July 21st, the Council passed the Student Activity Fund Theatrical and Music Performance Expenditures Emergency Act of 2020; that emergency legislation will expire on November 11, 2020. On September 22, 2020, the Council passed the Student Activity Fund Theatrical and Music Performance Expenditures Temporary Act of 2020, which is undergoing mayoral review; as such, the temporary act will not be effective when the emergency act

expires. This emergency legislation is necessary to prevent a gap in the law between the expiration of the emergency act and the effective date of the temporary act.

The underlying emergency and temporary acts extended prior legislation passed on emergency. On October 8, 2019, I introduced the Student Activity Fund Theatrical and Music Performance Expenditures Act of 2019; the Committee on Education and the Committee of the Whole held a joint hearing on the legislation on March 10, 2020. On October 8, 2019, the Council passed the Student Activity Fund Theatrical and Music Performance Expenditures Emergency Act of 2019, which was effective October 23; that emergency legislation expired on January 21, 2020. On October 22, 2019, the Council passed the Student Activity Fund Theatrical and Music Performance Expenditures Temporary Act of 2019, which was effective January 10, 2020; the temporary legislation expired on August 22, 2020.
