A RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To declare the existence of an emergency with respect to the need to approve Contract No. NFPHCSUPP-20-C Modifications 2 and 3 between the Not-for-Profit Hospital Corporation, commonly known as United Medical Center (“Hospital”), and Morrison Management Specialist, Inc. to provide Food and Nutrition services to the Hospital to support the COVID-19 pandemic and regular operations, and to authorize payment for the services received and to be received under the Contract.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the “Contract No. NFPHCSUPP-20-C Modifications 2 and 3 between the Not-for-Profit Hospital Corporation and Morrison Management Specialist, Inc. Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2020”.

Sec. 2. (a) There exists an immediate need to approve Modifications 2 and 3 to Contract No. NFPHCSUPP-20-C (“Contract”) between the Not-for-Profit Hospital Corporation (“Hospital”) and Morrison Management Specialist, Inc, to provide Food and Nutrition services to the Hospital to support the COVID-19 pandemic and for regular operations, and to authorize payment for the services received and to be received under this Contract.

37 (b) Council approved the base year of the Contract (August 1, 2019 – July 31,
38 2020) for \$2,218,174.14 on March 3, 2020 (A23-249).

39 (c) On March 11, 2020, Mayor Bowser issued the first COVID-19 related
40 emergency and public health emergency orders. NFPHC’s participation in the Mayor’s
41 Surge Task Force led to the realization that additional food and nutrition services were
42 needed.

43 (d) To timely meet the District’s Surge response requirements, the Hospital
44 procured these additional food and nutrition services in the amount of \$461,415.00,
45 effective date of May 5, 2020 (“Modification 2”).

46 (e) Proposed Modification 2 does not change the Council approved base period
47 (August 1, 2019 – July 31, 2020), but does increase the total value of the base year to
48 \$2,269,589.14.

49 (f) Proposed Modification 3 of the Contract seeks to exercise option year 1 of the
50 Contract (August 1, 2020 – July 31, 2021) for a value of \$1,757,253.00.

51 (g) This Contract has an aggregate value that exceeds \$1 million in a 12-month
52 period, and therefore Council approval is necessary.

53 (h) Emergency approval of this Contract for \$2,218,668 is necessary to prevent
54 any impact to the hospital’s provision of Food and Nutrition services.

55 (i) Without this approval, Morrison Management Specialist, Inc. cannot be paid
56 for these critical services provided and to be provided in excess of \$999,999.99.

57 Sec. 3. The Council determines that the circumstances enumerated in section 2
58 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that Contract No. NFPHCSUPP-
59 20-C Modifications 2 and 3 between the Not-for-Profit Hospital Corporation and
60 Morrison Management Specialist, Inc. Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency
61 Amendment Act of 2020, be adopted after a single reading.
