35	Virtual Meeting Emergency Amendment Act of 2020, effective November 2, 2020 (D.C. Act 23-
36	453; 67 DCR 13075) which expires on January 6, 2021.

37	(b) On November 10, 2020, the Council passed the Common Interest Community Virtual
38	Meeting Emergency Amendment Act of 2020 (D.C. Act 23-501; 67 DCR XXX) ("temporary
39	act"), which will not be transmitted to Congress until January 2021.
40	(c) This identical emergency legislation is necessary to prevent a gap in the law between
41	the expiration of the emergency act and the effective date of the temporary measure.
42	Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the circumstances in
