

A PROPOSED RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To declare the existence of an emergency, due to congressional review, with respect to the need to provide the Mayor the authority to make a property ineligible for residential parking permits when it is a condition of a zoning order.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the “RPP Voluntary Exclusion Congressional Review Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2021”.

Sec. 2. (a) On July 21, 2020, the Council passed the RPP Voluntary Exclusion Emergency Act of 2020, effective August 14, 2020 (D.C. Act 23-385; 67 DCR 9876), which expired on November 11, 2020.

(b) On September 22, 2020, the Council passed the RPP Voluntary Exclusion Temporary Act of 2020 (“temporary act”), which is undergoing congressional review, and will not be in effect on January 23, 2021.

(c) On October 6, 2020, the Council passed the RPP Voluntary Exclusion Congressional Review Emergency Act of 2020 (“congressional review emergency act”), which will expire on January 23, 2021.

31 (d) This emergency legislation is necessary to prevent a gap in the law between the  
32 expiration of the congressional review emergency act and the effective date of the temporary act.

33 Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the circumstances  
34 enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that the RPP  
35 Voluntary Exclusion Congressional Review Emergency Act of 2021 be adopted after a single  
36 reading.

37 Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
