Emergency and Temporary Measures

- **“Metropolitan Police Department Overtime Spending Accountability Congressional Review Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2021”**
- **“Metropolitan Police Department Overtime Spending Accountability Congressional Review Emergency Act of 2021”**

This legislation requires the Metropolitan Police Department to provide a written report every 2 pay periods on its overtime pay spending to the Council, and to require those reports to include the amount spent year-to-date on overtime pay and describe the staffing plan and conditions justifying the overtime pay.

On November 17, 2020, the Council passed the Metropolitan Police Department Overtime Spending Accountability Emergency Act of 2020, effective December 9, 2020, which will expire on March 8, 2021. On December 1, 2020, the Council passed the Metropolitan Police Department Overtime Spending Accountability Temporary Act of 2020, enacted on December 23, 2020, which is awaiting transmittal for congressional review. This congressional review emergency legislation is necessary to prevent a gap in the law between the expiration of the emergency act and the effective date of the temporary act.
