16	To declare the existence of an emergency, due to congressional review, with respect to the need
17 18	to amend Chapter 10 of Title 47 of the District of Columbia Official Code to provide a
19	real property tax exemption to the properties designated as Lots 824 and 826, Square 2950, to provide recordation and transfer tax exemptions for documents recorded with
20	respect to such properties, to require the developer to spend a certain percentage of its
21	total project budget with certified and small business enterprises, and to require the
22	developer to report that spending to the Department of Small and Local Business
23	Development.

25	RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this
26	resolution may be cited as the "Children's Hospital Research and Innovation Campus Equitable
27	Tax Relief Congressional Review Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2021".
28	Sec. 2. (a) In 2020, the Council passed emergency and temporary legislation to continue
29	Children's Hospital tax exemption to aide it in completing the development of its research and
30	innovation campus. The Children's Hospital Research and Innovation Campus Equitable Tax
31	Relief Temporary Amendment Act of 2020, effective June 24, 2020 (D.C. Law 23-124; 67 DCF
32	8984) ("temporary act"), will expire on February 4, 2021.

33	(b) On December 1, 2020, the Council passed the Children's Hospital Research and
34	Innovation Campus Equitable Tax Relief Act of 2020, enacted on December 22, 2020 (D.C. Act
35	23-546; 68 DCR 00110 ("permanent act"), which has not completed the 30-daycongressional
36	review period required by section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act,
37	approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and has not
38	yet become law.
39	(c) It is important that the provisions of the temporary act continue in effect, without
40	interruption, until the permanent act is law.
41	Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the circumstances
42	enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that the
43	Children's Hospital Research and Innovation Campus Equitable Tax Relief Congressional
44	Review Emergency Act of 2021 be adopted after a single reading.
45	Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
