A BILL

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To approve, on an emergency basis, proposed Modification No. 4 to Contract No. CFOPD-18-C-018 with Tax Management Associates, Inc. to continue provide audit services related to District residential property tax relief programs for the Office of the Chief Financial Officer, Office of Tax and Revenue and to authorize payment for services received and to be received under the contract.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA,
That this act may be cited as the “Contract No. CFOPD-18-C-018 Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Act of 2021”.

Sec. 2. Pursuant to Section 451 of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 803; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.51), and notwithstanding the requirements of the District of Columbia Procurement Practices Reform Act of 2010, effective April 8, 2011 (D.C. Law 18-0371; D.C. Official Code §2-352.02), the Council approves Modification No. 4 to Contract No. CFOPD-18-C-018 with Tax Management Associates, Inc. to continue provide audit services related to District residential property tax relief programs for the Office of the Chief Financial Officer, Office of Tax and Revenue and authorizes payment in the maximum not to exceed amount of \$2,983,180.00 for services received and to be received.

Sec. 3. The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement provided by the Chief Financial

4 Sec. 4. This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto
5 by the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), and shall remain in effect for no longer
6 than 90 days, as provided for emergency acts of the Council of the District of Columbia in
7 section 412(a) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87
8 Stat. 788; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.12(a)).
