RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the "Special Committee to Examine Education Governance Establishment Resolution of 2021". Sec. 2. Establishment of a Special Committee on Education Governance. (a) Pursuant to section 251 of the Rules of Organization and Procedure for the Council of the District of Columbia, Council Period 24 ("Council Rules"), there is established the Special Committee to Examine Education Governance ("Special Committee"). Sec. 3. Chairmanship and Membership of the Special Committee. (a) Councilmember Robert C. White, Jr. shall chair the Special Committee. (b)(1) The Special Committee shall be comprised of four additional members of the Council of the District of Columbia. (2) The Special Committee chair shall appoint members of the Special

55	(a) A hearing of the Special Committee may be called by the chair, which shall be held
