A BILL

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To approve, on an emergency basis, Modifications 10 and 11 to Contract No. CW34843 with Covanta Fairfax, Inc. to provide solid waste disposal services at an existing licensed and permitted waste-to-energy facility, and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under that contract.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA,

That this act may be cited as the “Modifications to Contract No. CW34843 with Covanta Fairfax, Inc. Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Act of 2021”.

Sec. 2. Pursuant to section 451 of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 803; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.51), and notwithstanding the requirements of section 202 of the Procurement Practices Reform Act of 2010, effective April 8, 2011 (D.C. Law 18-371; D.C. Official Code § 2-352.02), the Council approves Modifications 10 and 11 to Contract No. CW34843 with Covanta Fairfax, Inc. to provide solid waste disposal services at an existing licensed and permitted waste-to-energy facility, and authorizes payment in the total estimated contract amount of \$9,419,750.00 for the goods and services received and to be received under the contract for the period from January 1, 2021 through December 31, 2021.

1 Sec. 3. The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement provided by the Chief
2 Financial Officer as the fiscal impact statement required by section 4a of the General
3 Legislative Procedures Act of 1975, approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C.
4 Official Code § 1-301.47a).

5 Sec. 4. This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the
6 event of veto by the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), and shall remain
7 in effect for no longer than 90 days, as provided for emergency acts of the Council of the
8 District of Columbia in section 412(a) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act,
9 approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 788; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.12(a)).
