18	Sec. 2. Section 105 of the New Convention Center Hotel Omnibus Financing and
19	Development Act of 2006, effective September 19, 2006 (D.C. Law 16-163; D.C. Official Code
20	§ 10-1221.05), is amended by adding a new subsection (d) to read as follows:
21	"(d)(1) The Council approves and authorizes the issuance of a replacement bond to the
22	Authority as security for any refunding bonds issued by the Authority for purposes of refunding
23	a series of bonds of the Authority that are secured by a bond issued pursuant to this act.
24	"(2) The issuance of the replacement bond shall comply with the requirements of
25	this act; except, that the principal amount of any replacement bond issued pursuant to this
26	subsection shall be in an amount equal to the principal amount of the refunding bonds issued by
27	the Authority.".

This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the 33 34 Mayor action by the Council to override the veto), and shall remain in effect for no longer than 35 90 days, as provided for emergency acts of the Council of the District of Columbia in section 412(a) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 788; 36 37 68 D.C. Official Code § 1-204.12(a)).
