Council Chairman Phil Mendelson announces a public roundtable before the Committee of the Whole on the matter of Bill 24-128, "District of Columbia Retirement Board Leadership Amendment Act of 2021." The roundtable will be held **Friday, March 12, 2021, at 9:00 a.m.** via Zoom video conference.

The stated purpose of **Bill 24-128** is to amend the District of Columbia Retirement Reform Act to increase the maximum compensation of Board members, allow for the Executive Director to be a non-resident and increase the maximum compensation for the Executive Director and Chief Investment Officer. The purpose of this roundtable is to examine, in the near term before passage of a final bill, what impediments may exist with regard to the Board's ability to recruit and hire a qualified Executive Director given the current salary cap and residency requirement for the position in the District law and how to address those impediments in the near term.
