**SUBJECT:** Request to Place Emergency Measures on the Agenda for April 6, 2021  
Legislative Meeting

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This memo is to request that the following measures be placed on the agenda for the April 6, 2021 Legislative Meeting:

- **Modifications to Human Care Agreement No. RM-17-HCA-SATSR-004-CSS-BY4-CPS with Clean & Sober Streets, Inc. Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2021**
- **Modifications to Human Care Agreement No. RM-17-HCA-SATSR-004-CSS-BY4-CPS with Clean & Sober Streets, Inc. Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Act of 2021**

The modifications are to the agreement through the Department of Behavioral Health with Clean & Sober Street, Inc. for Level III, Substance Abuse Treatment Residential (SATR) services for authorized DBH consumers. Core services include diagnostic assessments, counseling, case management, crisis intervention, medication management, clinical care coordination, and treatment. The base period amount was approved for \$2.5M (CA22-0365), and Option Years One and Two were approved for identical amounts (CA22-0532 and CA23-0170, respectively). The contract is currently in Option Year Three (July 21, 2020 through July 20, 2021).

Modification No. 8 executed a partial Option Year Three in the not-to-exceed amount of \$200,000 for July 21 through September 30, 2020. Modification No. 9 extended the option period to December 31, 2020, at no additional cost. Modification No. 10 executed an additional partial Option Year Three in the not-to-exceed amount of \$790,000 (December 1, 2020 through January 31, 2021). Modification No. 11 extended the partial option period to February 28, 2021. Modification No. 12 extended the partial option period again to March 3, 2021. Modification No.

13 is now necessary to exercise the remainder of Option Year Three in the not-to-exceed amount of \$1.2M, which will increase the total amount to \$2.2M.

The modifications are to the agreement through the Department of Behavioral Health with Federal City Recovery Services for Level III, Substance Abuse Treatment Residential (SATR) services for authorized DBH consumers. Core services include diagnostic assessments, counseling, case management, crisis intervention, medication management, clinical care coordination, and treatment. The base period amount was approved for \$5M (CA22-0323), and Option Years One and Two were approved for identical amounts (CA22-0539 and CA23-0202, respectively). The contract is currently in Option Year Three (July 21, 2020 through July 20, 2021).

Modification No. 8 executed a partial Option Year Three in the not-to-exceed amount of \$100,000 (July 21, 2020 through September 30, 2020). Modification No. 9 extended the option period to December 31, 2020, at no additional cost. Modification No. 10 executed an additional partial option period in the not-to-exceed amount of \$890,000 through January 31, 2021. Modification No. 11 extended the option period to February 28, 2021. Modification No. 12 extended the option period again to March 31, 2021. Modification No. 13 is now necessary to exercise the remainder of the option year in the not-to-exceed amount of \$2.6M, increasing the total not-to-exceed amount to \$3.6M. Modification is necessary to allow for the continuation of these vital services.

- **Modifications to Human Care Agreement No. RM-17-HCA-SATSR-011-RAP-BY4-CPS with RAP, Inc. Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2021**
- **Modifications to Human Care Agreement No. RM-17-HCA-SATSR-011-RAP-BY4-CPS with RAP, Inc. Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Act of 2021**

The modifications are to the agreement through the Department of Behavioral Health with RAP, Inc. for Level III, Substance Abuse Treatment Residential (SATR) services for authorized DBH consumers. Core services include diagnostic assessments, counseling, case management, crisis intervention, medication management, clinical care coordination, and treatment. The base period amount was approved for \$2.5M (CA22-0366), and Option Years One and Two were approved for identical amounts (CA22-0540 and CA23-0169, respectively). The contract is currently in Option Year Three (July 21, 2020 through July 20, 2021).

Modification No. 8 executed a partial Option Year Three for the period from July 21, 2020 through September 20, 2020, in the not-to-exceed amount of \$200,000. Modification No. 9 extended the option period at no additional cost (September 30, 2020 through December 31, 2020).

Modification No. 10 executed an additional partial Option Year Three in the not-to-exceed amount of \$790,000, increasing the total amount to \$990,000 (December 31, 2020 through January 31, 2021). Modification No. 11 extended the option period from January 31, 2021 through February 28, 2021, at no additional cost. Modification No. 12 extended the option period to March 31, 2021 at no additional cost. Modification No. 13 is now necessary to exercise the remainder of Option Year Three in the not-to-exceed amount of \$1.2M, increasing the total not-to-exceed amount for the period to \$2.2M. These modifications are necessary to allow for the continuation of vital services.

- **Modifications to Human Care Agreement No. RM-17-HCA-SATSR-009-SII-BY4-CPS with Samaritan Inns, Inc. Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2021**
- **Modifications to Human Care Agreement No. RM-17-HCA-SATSR-009-SII-BY4-CPS with Samaritan Inns, Inc. Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Act of 2021**

The modifications are to the agreement through the Department of Behavioral Health with Samaritan Inns, Inc. for Level III, Substance Abuse Treatment Residential (SATR) services for authorized DBH consumers. Core services include diagnostic assessments, counseling, case management, crisis intervention, medication management, clinical care coordination, and treatment. The base period amount was approved for \$2.5M (CA22-0466), and Option Years One and Two were approved for identical amounts (CA22-0579 and CA23-0364, respectively). The contract is currently in Option Year Three (September 7, 2020 through September 6, 2021).

Modification No. 13 executed a partial Option Year Three for the not-to-exceed amount of \$200,000 (September 7, 2020 through December 31, 2020). Modification No. 14 executed additional partial Option Year Three in the not-to-exceed amount of \$790,000, increasing the total amount to \$990,000 (December 31, 2020 through January 31, 2021). Modification No. 15 extended Partial Option Year Three from January 31, 2021 through February 28, 2021, at no additional cost. Modification No. 16 extended the option period from February 28, 2021 through March 31, 2021, at no additional cost. Modification No. 17 is now necessary to exercise the remainder of Option Year Three in the not-to-exceed amount of \$1.2M, increasing the total amount for the option period to \$2.2M. Modification is necessary to allow for the continuation of these vital services.

- **Modification Nos. 17, 18, 19 and 20 to Contract No. CW80004 with Anchor Mental Health Association Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2021**
- **Modification Nos. 17, 18, 19 and 20 to Contract No. CW80004 with Anchor Mental Health Association Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Act of 2021**

The modifications are to the contract through the Department of Behavioral Health with Anchor Mental Health Association, Inc. for Mental Health Rehabilitation Services (MHRS) delivery networks located within the Washington, DC Metropolitan area. Anchor works in tandem with

DBH to provide consumers with Diagnostic/Assessment, Medication/Somatic, Counseling and Psychotherapy, Community Support Services, and Supported Employment Services. The base period amount was approved for \$2.5M (CA22-0522), and Option Years One and Two were approved for identical amounts (CA22-0599 and CA23-0279, respectively). The contract is currently in Option Year Three (October 1, 2020 through September 30, 2021).

Modification No. 17 exercised a partial option of Option Year Three for the not-to-exceed amount of \$700,000 (October 1, 2020 through December 31, 2020). Modification No. 18 extended the partial option period from January 1, 2021 through February 28, 2021, at no additional cost. Similarly, Modification No. 19 extended the partial option period from March 1, 2021 through March 31, 2021, at no additional cost. Modification 20 is now necessary to exercise the remainder of the Option Year Three and increase the total not-to-exceed amount for the option year to \$1.5M. Modification is necessary to allow for the continuation of these vital services.

- **Contract No. AGR2021-022 with the Arizona Department of Health Services Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2021**
- **Contract No. AGR2021-022 with the Arizona Department of Health Services Emergency Approval Resolution of 2021**

This resolution would approve the proposed Cooperative Purchasing Agreement between the Arizona Department of Health Services and the Department of Health to provide a new management information system for the supplemental nutrition program for women, infants and children (WIC) in a not-to-exceed amount of \$3.1M. This agreement would formalize the Arizona WIC Programs and the District's Program's roles in implementing and maintaining the Health and Nutrition Delivery System (HANDS) and eWIC systems in the District Program.

- **Contract No. NFPHC-2018-465 Modifications 3C-7 between the Not-for-Profit Hospital Corporation and Mazars USA LLP Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2021**
- **Contract No. NFPHC-2018-465 Modifications 3C-7 between the Not-for-Profit Hospital Corporation and Mazars USA LLP Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Amendment Act of 2021**

This emergency legislation and declaration resolution would provide retroactive approval for Contract No. NFPHC-2018-465 Modifications 3C-7 between the Not-for-Profit Hospital Corporation and Mazars USA LLP to provide hospital operator services, and authorize payment for the services received and to be received under this proposed Contract.

Council action is necessary to approve Modifications 3C-7 that comprise the partial exercise of Option Year 3 (October 1, 2020 – April 6, 2021) for a total amount of \$3,646,384.08, in the corrected amounts as follows:

- Modification 3C October 1, 2020 – November 10, 2020 \$795,222.06
- Modification 4C November 11, 2020 – November 18, 2020 \$155,165.28
- Modification 5C November 19, 2020 – December 31, 2020 \$834,013.38

- Modification 6C January 1, 2021 – March 7, 2021 \$1,280,113.56
- Modification 7 March 8, 2021 – April 6, 2021 \$581,869.80

The Contract requires affirmative approval due to the additional time needed for negotiation of the new hospital operator contract, to obtain Board and Council approvals, and account for Council's CY2021 legislative calendar. The Council has already approved the base period (CA22-391), Option Year 1 (A22-525), and Option Year 2 (A23-154) of the Contract.

Emergency approval of this legislation and declaration resolution would approve this Contract, prevent a gap in services, and enable Mazars USA LLP to receive payment for the provision of these critical services at UMC.

- **Contract No. NFPHC-OPS-21-C-00038 between the Not-for-Profit Hospital Corporation and Mazars USA LLP Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2021**
- **Contract No. NFPHC-OPS-21-C-00038 between the Not-for-Profit Hospital Corporation and Mazars USA LLP Emergency Approval Resolution of 2021**

This emergency declaration resolution and approval resolution would provide emergency approval for Contract No. NFPHC-OPS-21-C-00038 between the Not-for-Profit Hospital Corporation and Mazars USA for the continued provision hospital operator services. Mazars currently provides substantially similar services under a 2018 contract that had to be extended during negotiations; Council approval is being sought under separate legislation.

Council action is necessary to approve the proposed sole sourced Contract's six (6) month base period, which ends September 30, 2021, due its total value of \$3,617,788. The method of procurement allows for continuity and stability during transition and wind down ahead of the Fall 2024 opening of the New Hospital at St. Elizabeths East; the criticality of this period and the Contractor's performance were discussed during the Committee on Health's FY21 Performance Oversight Hearing. Emergency approval of these declaration and approval resolutions at would approve this Contract and prevent a gap in services.
