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20 RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this  
21 resolution may be cited as the “Corporate Filing Extension Clarification Declaration Resolution  
22 of 2021”.

23 Sec. 2. (a) On March 11, 2020, the Mayor declared a public emergency due to pandemic.  
24 The District of Columbia has remained under a public health crisis for over a year and continues  
25 to be in a state of crisis.

26 (b) In 2020 the Council of the District of Columbia extended the deadline to file the  
27 biennial report until June 1, 2020.

28 (c) This emergency legislation is necessary to provide an extension while the public  
29 health crisis continues.

30 Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the circumstances  
31 enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that the  
32 Corporate Filing Extension Clarification Declaration Resolution of 2021 be adopted after a  
33 single reading.

34           Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.

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
