Cheh Councilmember Trayon White, Sr. A BILL IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA To declare the existence of an emergency, with respect to the need to have no late fee for delivering biennial report for 2021 if the biennial report for 2021 is delivered to the Mayor for filing by June 30, 2021. RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the "Corporate Filing Extension Clarification Declaration Resolution of 2021". Sec. 2. (a) On March 11, 2020, the Mayor declared a public emergency due to pandemic. The District of Columbia has remained under a public health crisis for over a year and continues to be in a state of crisis. (b) In 2020 the Council of the District of Columbia extended the deadline to file the biennial report until June 1, 2020. (c) This emergency legislation is necessary to provide an extension while the public health crisis continues. Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the circumstances enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that the Corporate Filing Extension Clarification Declaration Resolution of 2021 be adopted after a single reading.

Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
