

A CEREMONIAL RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To recognize and honor Andrew L. Ross, Ph.D., LCSW-C, for his long and distinguished career dedicated to the youth of the District of Columbia.

WHEREAS, Dr. Andrew Ross came to The Children’s Guild in 1995 as President and CEO, following a distinguished career at Children’s Square USA in Council Bluffs, Iowa, and Bellefaire-Jewish Children’s Bureau in Cleveland, Ohio, when the organization had a \$6 million budget with two special needs schools and one group home;

WHEREAS, today, The Children’s Guild Alliance has a budget of more than \$80 million and serves approximately 6,000 children in Maryland and Washington D.C. through special needs schools, charter schools, therapeutic group homes, a treatment foster care program, and a behavioral health program that operates in 90 schools in Maryland;

WHEREAS, Dr. Ross was instrumental in developing TranZed Apprenticeships, returning pre-school programming to The Children’s Guild and establishing the Transformation Education Institute, which provides innovative ideas and makes the latest developments in neuroscience accessible to teachers and organizations throughout the U.S. and several foreign countries;

WHEREAS, among Dr. Ross’s greatest contributions has been the introduction of Transformation Education and caring for the whole child. Transformation Education puts the needs of the child ahead of the needs of the adult and creates a culture of learning to meet the individualized learning styles of each child using brain-based learning methods;

WHEREAS, Dr. Ross launched Kids First, a national movement to transform the way America cares for and educates its children. He will continue to serve as senior advisor to Kids First;

46 WHEREAS, among his many honors, Dr. Ross was selected as one of the 10 Most
47 Mannered Men in America and received the following distinctions: Innovator of the Year Award
48 from The Daily Record for his work in child welfare; Innovator of the Year Award from the
49 National Association Special Education Centers for his work in special education; and a Smart
50 CEO Corporate Culture Award;

52 WHEREAS, Dr. Ross has been active in many professional and civic organizations over
53 the years to include serving as president of the Towsontowne Rotary Club and a trustee of Brown
54 Memorial Presbyterian Church. He is also active in the Order of the Sons of Italy in America and
55 the Association of Italian American Charities;

57 WHEREAS, on November 6, 2021, The Children’s Guild Alliance at its Kids First
58 Celebration will honor Dr. Ross for his amazing accomplishments over the past 26 years; and

60 WHEREAS, Dr. Andrew Ross’s long and distinguished career dedicated to youth in the
61 District of Columbia and nationwide is reason for recognition and celebration.
