34	Transformation Education and caring for the whole child. Transformation Education puts the
35	needs of the child ahead of the needs of the adult and creates a culture of learning to meet the
36	individualized learning styles of each child using brain-based learning methods;
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38	WHEREAS, Dr, Ross launched Kids First, a national movement to transform the way
39	America cares for and educates its children. He will continue to serve as senior advisor to Kids
