

AN ACT

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To repeal, on an emergency basis, section 103 of the Coronavirus Support Emergency Amendment Act of 2021.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the “Shared Work Clarification Emergency Amendment Act of 2021”.

Sec. 2. The Coronavirus Support Emergency Amendment Act of 2021, passed on emergency basis on March 2, 2021 (Enrolled version of Bill 24-139), is amended by repealing section 103.

Sec. 3. Applicability.

This act shall apply as of the effective date of the Coronavirus Support Emergency Amendment Act of 2021, effective March 17, 2021 (Enrolled version of Bill 24-139).

Sec. 4. Fiscal impact statement.

The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement in the Budget Director as the fiscal impact statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975, approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).

Sec. 5. Effective date.

This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), and shall remain in effect for no longer than 90 days, as provided for emergency acts of the Council of the District of Columbia in section

30 412(a) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 788;

31 D.C. Official Code § 1-204.12(a)).
