18 To declare the existence of an emergency with respect to the need to amend the Coronavirus
19 Support Emergency Amendment Act of 2021 by repealing the shared work provision in
20 that measure.

22 RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this
23 resolution may be cited as the “Shared Work Clarification Emergency Declaration Resolution of
24 2021”.

25 Sec. 2. (a) On July 28, 2020, the Council passed the Shared Work Compensation Program
26 Clarification Amendment Act of 2020 as part of the Fiscal Year 2021 Budget Support Act of
27 2020 (“permanent measure”), which took effect on December 18, 2020.

28 (b) The Coronavirus Support Emergency Amendment Act of 2021 passed on emergency
29 basis on March 2, 2021 (Enrolled version of Bill 24-139), (“emergency measure”) includes, as
30 section 103, language that is substantively the same as that in permanent measure except that
31 section 103 uses the term “state” to refer to the District whereas the permanent measures uses the
32 preferred term “District.”

33 (c) Because the permanent measure is already in effect, there is no reason for section 103,
34 which differs from the permanent, to be in effect on an emergency basis, and it should be
35 repealed to avoid confusion.

36 Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the circumstances
37 enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that the Shared
38 Work Clarification Emergency Act of 2021 be adopted after a single reading.

39 Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
