

A BILL

IN THE COUNCIL OF DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To amend, on a temporary basis, section 47-1332 of the District of Columbia Official Code to cancel the tax sale in calendar year 2021, and to require that notice of the cancellation be mailed to affected property owners.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the "Real Property Tax Sale COVID-19 Equitable Temporary Amendment Act of 2021".

Sec. 2. Section 47-1332 of the District of Columbia Official Code is amended as follows:

(a) Subsection (a) is amended by striking the phrase "(c) and (d)" and inserting the phrase "(c), (d), and (d-1)" in its place.

(b) A new subsection (d-1) is added to read as follows:

"(d-1)(1) No tax sale shall be held during calendar year 2021.

"(2) The Chief Financial Officer shall mail notice of the cancellation to each person who was mailed a notice of tax delinquency pursuant to § 47-1341(a) to the same address to which the notice of tax delinquency was mailed.

Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement.

39 (a) This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by
40 the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of Congressional review
41 as provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December
42 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of
43 Columbia Register.

44 (b) This act shall expire after 225 days of its having taken effect.
