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21 RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this
22 resolution may be cited as the “Advisory Neighborhood Commissions Humanitarian Relief
23 Extension Congressional Review Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2021”.

24 Sec. 2. (a) In August 2021, the Council enacted legislation to amend the Coronavirus
25 Support Temporary Amendment Act of 2021 to extend the authority of Advisory Neighborhood
26 Commissions to approve grants for the purpose of providing humanitarian relief during the
27 public emergency.

28 (b) The Advisory Neighborhood Commissions Humanitarian Relief Extension
29 Emergency Amendment Act of 2021, effective August 23, 2021 (D.C. Act 24-0161; 68 DCR
30 0843), expires on November 21, 2021. The Advisory Neighborhood Commissions Humanitarian
31 Relief Extension Temporary Amendment Act of 2021 was transmitted to the Mayor on October
32 18, 2021, and is not expected to become law before the emergency legislation expires.

1 (c) It is important that the provisions of the emergency legislation continue in effect,
2 without interruption, until the temporary legislation takes effect.

3 Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the circumstances
4 enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that the
5 “Advisory Neighborhood Commissions Humanitarian Relief Extension Congressional Review
6 Emergency Amendment Act of 2021” be *adopted after a single reading*.

7 Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
