25	Sec. 2. Section 406 of the District of Columbia Government Comprehensive Merit
26	Personnel Act of 1978, effective March 3, 1979 (D.C. Law 2-139; D.C. Official Code § 1-
27	604.06), is amended by adding a new subsection (c) to read as follows:
28	"(c) For the purposes of enforcing the Council's COVID-19 Vaccination Policy
29	("policy"), the Chairman of the Council may, consistent with the policy, take disciplinary action
30	against Council employees for failing to comply with the policy, up to and including termination.
31	The Chairman's authority under this paragraph, when exercised, shall supersede the authority
32	granted to another councilmember pursuant to subsection (b)(3)(B) of this section.".

41	412(a) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 788;
42	D.C. Official Code § 1-204.12(a)).
