Council Chairman Phil Mendelson announces the scheduling of a public hearing of the Committee of the Whole on School Librarians in District of Columbia Public Schools (DCPS). The hearing will be held on **Tuesday**, **November 23, 2021**, at 11:00 a.m. via Zoom Video Conference Broadcast.

The purpose of this hearing is to hear from District of Columbia Public Schools (DCPS) on the status of having a school librarian in every school. As of July 2021 there were 36 schools in DCPS without a full-time School Librarian due to the flexibility afforded to principals to forego having a school librarian in lieu of another position. A disproportionate number of these schools were in Wards 7 and 8. Amendments were successfully introduced to B24-275 and B24-281, the Fiscal Year 2022 Local Budget and Local Budget Emergency Acts of 2021, respectively, to attempt to remedy this problem temporarily, and this hearing intends to explore possible permanent solutions.
