A BILL

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To approve, on an emergency basis, the reprogramming request of Fiscal Year 2021 operating local funds in the amount of \$30,195,173.00 from various agencies to the Emergency Planning and Security Fund, Department of General Services, Department of Consumer and Regulatory Affairs, Department of Health, and Department of Public Works.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the “FY 2021 Reprogramming Request of \$30,195,173 from Various Agencies to the Emergency Planning and Security Fund, Department of General Services, Department of Consumer and Regulatory Affairs, Department of Health, and Department of Public Works Revised Emergency Approval Act of 2021”.

Sec. 2. (a) Pursuant to section 47-363 of the District of Columbia Official Code, the Mayor transmitted to the Council a reprogramming request in the amount of \$30,195,173.00 from various agencies to the Emergency Planning and Security Fund, Department of General Services, Department of Consumer and Regulatory Affairs, Department of Health, and Department of Public Works.

(b) The Council approves the \$30,195,173.00 reprogramming request.

Sec. 3. Effective date.

31 This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the
32 Mayor, action by the Council to override that veto), and shall remain in effect for no longer than
33 90 days, as provided for emergency acts of the Council of the District of Columbia in section
34 412(a) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 788;
35 D.C. Official Code § 1-204.12(a)) .
