A BILL

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To amend, on an emergency basis, the Commission on the Arts and Humanities Act to confirm the reappointment of Natalie Hopkinson and Cora Masters Barry as members of the Commission on the Arts and Humanites, for terms ending June 30, 2024.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the “Commission on the Arts and Humanities Member Confirmation Emergency Amendment Act of 2021”.

Sec. 2. The Council approves the following proposed resolutions:

(1) PR24-244, the Commission on the Arts and Humanities Natalie Hopkinson Confirmation Resolution of 2021; and

(2) PR24-245, the Commission on the Arts and Humanities Cora Masters Barry Confirmation Resolution of 2021.

Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement.

The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement of the Budget Director as the fiscal impact statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975, approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-307.47a).

35 Sec. 4. Effective date.

36 This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the
37 Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), and shall remain in effect for no longer than
38 90 days, as provided for emergency acts of the Council of the District of Columbia in section
39 412(a) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 788;
40 D.C. Official Code § 1-204.12(a)).
