Natalie Hopkinson and Cora Masters Barry to s	erve as members of the CAH, for terms ending
June 30, 2024.	
(c) The reappointment resolutions for bo	oth nominees were referred to the Committee of
the Whole, but no Council action has occurred t	to approve the nominations.

(d) It is critical that both nominations are approved by the Council to continue the
momentum and progress the CAH has been making towards ensuring greater equity in grant
funding for artists and arts organizations.
(a) Natalie Honkinson serves on the Public Art Committee and the Arts Education

- (g) Natalie Hopkinson serves on the Public Art Committee and the Arts Education

 Committee, while Cora Masters Barry services on the Grants Committee and the Inclusion,

 Diversity, Equity, & Acess Committee. It is clear they currently serve critical roles as members of the CAH.
- (g) Immediate action by the Council is necessary to prevent the reappointment resolutions from being deemed disapproved by the Council on November 3, 2021.
