Emergency Contract Legislation at the Request of the Executive

- "Modifications to Contract No. CW53496 with Laake Enterprises, Inc. d/b/a FESCO Emergency Sales Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2021"
- "Modifications to Contract No. CW53496 with Laake Enterprises, Inc. d/b/a FESCO Emergency Sales Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Act of 2021"

This emergency legislation would approve Modification Nos. 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, and 11 to Contract No. CW53496 with Laake Enterprises, Inc. d/b/a FESCO Emergency Sales to procure 18 Horton ambulances, which will replace ambulances in the Fire and Emergency Medical Services Department's current fleet. By Modification No. 6, dated September 25, 2020, the Office of Contracting and Procurement, on behalf of the Fire Emergency and Medical Services Department, exercised partial option year three of the contract, for the period from October 1, 2020 through January 31, 2021 in the not-to-exceed amount of \$830,712. Modification Nos. 7 through 10 were exercised at no cost to the District in the months since. Modification No. 11 is now necessary to increase the not-to-exceed amount of the contract by \$6,600,264 to a revised amount of \$7,430,976. Council approval is required because these modifications increase the total contract amount to more than \$1,000,000 during a 12-month period.
