**SUBJECT:** Requests for the December 7, 2021 Legislative Meeting

We request that the following emergency measures be agendized for the December 7, 2021 Legislative Meeting:

- Public Service Commission Member Qualifications Congressional Review Emergency Amendment Act of 2021
- Public Service Commission Member Qualifications Congressional Review Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2021

On October 18, 2021, the Council passed the Public Service Commission Member Qualifications Emergency Amendment Act of 2021. Because the emergency act contained a retroactive applicability date of October 1, 2021, the emergency act will expire on December 30, 2021.

On November 2, 2021, the Council passed the Public Service Commission Member Qualifications Temporary Amendment Act of 2021, which is undergoing mayoral review, and will not be in effect on December 30, 2021.

This congressional review emergency legislation is necessary to prevent a gap in the law between the expiration of the emergency act and the effective date of the temporary act.
