



17 A CEREMONIAL RESOLUTION

19  
20 IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

24 To recognize and honor the Archbishop Carroll High School football team and congratulate the  
25 student-athletes on their win at the DC State Athletic Association championship, record  
26 breaking season, and many academic accomplishments.

27  
28 WHEREAS, Archbishop Carroll High School is a private college preparatory school in  
29 Washington, DC that welcomes young people and empowers them in an academically rigorous,  
30 diverse, and supportive learning environment;

31  
32 WHEREAS, Archbishop Carroll High School supports student-athletes on and off the field  
33 to be successful in all that they do;

34  
35 WHEREAS, the Archbishop Carroll High School varsity football team plays in the DC  
36 State Athletic Association (DCSAA) Class AA Division;

37  
38 WHEREAS, Coach Robert Harris, a 1991 graduate of Archbishop Carroll, returned to the  
39 school 6 years ago to reinvigorate the Lions and led the team all the way to the championship;

41 WHEREAS, the Lions regularly appeared in the Washington Post's Football Top 20  
42 throughout the 2021 season, an outcome of the team's consistent efforts and confirmation of their  
43 division dominance;

45 WHEREAS, the Archbishop Carroll Lions entered the championship with a stunning  
46 undefeated regular season, a feat the school had not achieved in decades;

48 WHEREAS, Archbishop Carroll faced Theodore Roosevelt High School on December 4,  
49 2021 at the DC State Athletic Association AA State Championship, and despite falling behind in  
50 the first half of the game, came back to win 35-27 in overtime by capitalizing on their celebrated  
51 running game;

52  
53 WHEREAS, by the end of the season, with 13 wins, the Archbishop Carroll Lions earned  
54 the distinction of the team with most wins in the school’s history;

55  
56 WHEREAS, Coach Robert Harris was named Metro Division Coach of the Year by the  
57 Washington Catholic Athletic Conference (WCAC);

58  
59 WHEREAS, the Archbishop Carroll Lions earned a team grade point average of 3.2, had  
60 six national honor society inductees, and 35 players to earn DCSAA Honor Roll certificates;

61  
62 WHEREAS, the Archbishop Carroll Lions completed more than 400 hours of community  
63 service; and

65 WHEREAS, the Archbishop Carroll Lions had 21 players earn all-conference honors, two  
66 players earn WCAC Co-Defensive Player of the Year, one player earn Co-Offensive Player of the  
67 Year, and one player earn Gatorade Player of the Year.

69 RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, this resolution  
70 may be cited as the “Archbishop Carroll High School Football Team Recognition Resolution of  
71 2021”.
