

A PROPOSED RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To approve, on an emergency basis, multiyear Contract No. CW90443 with Motorola Solutions, Inc. to provide maintenance and support for the Office of Unified Communications’ public radio systems.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the “Contract No CW90443 with Motorola Solutions, Inc. Emergency Approval Resolution of 2021.”

Sec. 2. (a) The Office of Contracting and Procurement, on behalf of the Office of Unified Communications, proposes to enter into multiyear Contract No. CW90443 with Motorola Solutions, Inc. to provide maintenance and support for the Office of Unified Communications’ public radio systems.

(b) The reason for the emergency is that the District currently operates 7,100 Motorola radios that have reached the end of their lifespan. The District requires new UL certified equipment to safely perform public safety communications on a continuous and uninterrupted basis. Supply chain delays are such that if this emergency procurement is not completed by the end of 2021, Motorola cannot deliver new equipment to the District until mid-2022 at a substantially higher price. Any delays will risk the safety of emergency personnel and District residents.

1 (c) The not-to-exceed price for the term of this multiyear contract with Motorola
2 Solutions, Inc. is \$69,111,669.56. The term will be from the date of award through September
3 30, 2027.

4 Sec. 3. Pursuant to section 451(c)(3) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act,
5 approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 803; Pub. L. 93-198; D.C. Official Code § 1-
6 204.51(c)(3)), the Council approves Contract No. CW90443.

7 Sec. 4. The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement provided by the Chief Financial
8 Officer as the fiscal impact statement required by section 602(c)(3) of the District of Columbia
9 Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; Pub. L. 93-198; D.C. Official Code
10 § 1-206.02(c)(3)).

11 Sec. 5. The Secretary to the Council shall transmit a copy of this resolution, upon its
12 adoption, to the Mayor.

13 Sec. 6. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
