15	To declare the existence of an emergency with respect to the need to amend the
16	Coronavirus Support Temporary Amendment Act of 2021 to authorize certain
17	emergency procurements deemed necessary to respond to changing public health
18	conditions and to protect the health and safety of District residents.

20	RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That
21	this resolution may be cited as the "Limited Emergency Procurement Extension
22	Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2021".
23	Sec. 2. (a) The Council acted to return the District to normal procurement
24	operations as of November 5, 2021, in order to ensure adequate transparency,
25	accountability, and competition in the District procurement system after approximately
26	20 months of expedited procurement authority pursuant to the declared public
27	emergency.
28	(b) Since November 5, 2021, the introduction of the Omicron variant and local
29	increases in coronavirus infections have further endangered the District's public health
30	and safety.
31	(c) The Mayor has indicated that normal procurement operations may result in
32	delays in certain procurements necessary to address public health needs, particularly

- where jurisdictions are competing for supplies from a limited number of national and international vendors.

  Sec. 3. Emergency declaration.

  The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the circumstances enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that the Limited Emergency Procurement Extension Emergency Amendment Act of 2021 be adopted on an emergency basis.
