This memorandum serves as notice that I intend to move an amendment to the following measure at the December 7, 2021, Legislative Meeting:

• B24-405, "COVID Vaccination Leave Temporary Amendment Act of 2021"

The legislation provides for paid leave for employees to receive the COVID vaccine or a booster, to take their children to receive the vaccine or a booster, or to recover from the side effects of the vaccine. In general, federal OSHA standards preempt state laws that relate to the same topic; this language would clarify that the District's law is not intended to violate such preemption. Specifically, this amendment would clarify that the law applies to the extent it is not preempted by the OSHA emergency temporary standard on COVID-19 vaccination and testing, issued November 5, 2021 (linked here) or the COVID-19 healthcare emergency temporary standard, issued June 17, 2021 (linked here).
