• PR 24-468 – Sense of the Council Eviction Prevention Resolution of 2021

This resolution declares the Sense of the Council that additional funds are necessary to prevent tenant evictions, and that both the US Treasury and the Mayor have an obligation to ensure there are sufficient emergency rental assistance funds available to District residents through the remainder of fiscal year 2022. The US Treasury recently announced it expects to reallocate only a limited amount of ERA funds, potentially requiring the Mayor to initiate reprogramming of local funds to stabilize the finances of the District's renters and landlord – this resolution affirms that the Council stands ready to work with the Mayor to ensure housing stability is maintained for a strong and equitable recovery.
