21	resolution may be cited as the "Office of Administrative Hearings Unemployment Appeals
22	Extension Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2022".
23	Sec. 2. (a) In August 2021, the Council enacted legislation to amend the Coronavirus
24	Support Temporary Amendment Act of 2021 to extend the tolling period for claimants to file
25	their unemployment insurance appeals.
26	(b) The Coronavirus Support Temporary Amendment Act of 2021 expires on February 4,
27	2022.
28	(c) The ongoing impact of the public health emergency, especially the emergency of new
29	variants of the coronavirus, continues to impact the timely filing and process of unemployment
30	appeals.
31	Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the circumstances
32	enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that the "Office

- 33 of Administrative Hearings Unemployment Appeals Extension Emergency Amendment Act of
- 34 2022" be adopted after a single reading.
- Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
