19	To amend, on a temporary basis, the Early Childhood Educator Equitable Compensation
20	Task Force Act of 2021 to extend the deadline for submission of the Early
21	Childhood Educator Equitable Compensation Task Force's report and

24	BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA,
25	That this act may be cited as the "Early Childhood Educator Equitable Compensation
26	Task Force Temporary Amendment Act of 2022".
27	Sec. 2. Section 1103(c) of the Early Childhood Educator Equitable Compensation
28	Task Force Act of 2021, effective November 13, 2021 (D.C. Law 24-45; D.C. Official
29	Code § 38-2242(c)), is amended as follows:
30	(a) Paragraph (1) is amended by striking the word "and".
31	(b) A new paragraph (1A) is added to read as follows:
32	"(1A) Submit a report to the Mayor and Council by January 15, 2022 that
33	proposes a mechanism for distributing the \$53,920,878 in local funding that is set aside in
34	the Early Childhood Educator Pay Equity Fund for Fiscal Year 2022; and".

35	(c) Paragraph (2) is amended by striking the phrase "January 15, 2022," and
36	inserting the phrase "April 15, 2022," in its place.
37	Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement.
38	The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement of the Budget Director as the
39	fiscal impact statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act
40	of 1975, approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-307.47a).
41	Sec. 4. Effective date.
42	This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of a
43	veto by the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of
44	congressional review as provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home
45	Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-
46	206.02(c)(1) and publication in the District of Columbia Register. This act shall expire
47	after 225 days of its having taken effect.
