

A PROPOSED RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To declare the existence of an emergency, due to congressional review, with respect to the need to amend Section 905 of the Coronavirus Support Temporary Amendment Act of 2021 to extend the authorization of pandemic election procedures to fill vacancies on Advisory Neighborhood Commissions and to reflect the reduced role of the Board of Elections in those procedures.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the “Advisory Neighborhood Commission Pandemic Election Procedures Extension Congressional Review Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2022”.

Sec. 2. (a) On October 19, 2021, the Council passed the Advisory Neighborhood Commission Pandemic Election Procedures Extension Emergency Amendment Act of 2021, effective October 20, 2021 (D.C. Act 24-0179; 68 DCR 011316). The emergency act will expire on January 18, 2022.

(b) On November 2, 2021, the Council passed the Advisory Neighborhood Commission Pandemic Election Procedures Extension Clarification Emergency Amendment Act of 2021, effective December 13, 2021 (D.C. Act 24-0233; 68 DCR 013251), with clarifying amendments to the prior emergency legislation.

(c) On November 2, 2021, the Council also passed the Advisory Neighborhood Commission Pandemic Election Procedures Extension Temporary Amendment Act of 2021

35 (D.C. Act 24-0227; 68 DCR 013225) on second reading, with amendments to match the
36 associated emergency, which is now undergoing congressional review and will not be in effect
37 before the associated emergency legislation expires.

38 (d) Congressional review legislation is necessary to prevent a gap in the law between the
39 expiration of the emergency act and the associated temporary legislation.

40 Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the circumstances
41 enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that the
42 “Advisory Neighborhood Commission Pandemic Election Procedures Extension Congressional
43 Review Emergency Amendment Act of 2022” be *adopted after a single reading*.

44 Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
