SUBJECT: Requests for the January 4, 2022 Legislative Meeting



I request that the following emergency measures be agendized for the January 4, 2022 Legislative Meeting:

- Post-Public Health Emergency Protections Extension Congressional Review Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2021
- Post-Public Health Emergency Protections Extension Congressional Review Emergency Amendment Act of 2021

On October 5, 2021, the Council passed the Post-Public Health Emergency Protections Extension Emergency Act of 2021, which was effective October 25, 2021, and will expire on January 23, 2022.

On November 2, 2021, the Council passed the Post-Public Health Emergency Protections Extension Temporary Act of 2021, which was enacted on November 18, 2021. The temporary act is still undergoing congressional review and has a projected law date of February 2, 2022, after the emergency act expires. Thus, this emergency legislation is necessary to prevent a gap in the law between the expiration of the emergency act and the effective date of the temporary act.
