IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

---

1 To amend, on an emergency basis, the Redistricting Procedure Act of 1981 to extend the  
2 deadline for submission of ward task force reports on the redistricting of ANC areas and  
3 single-member districts, and to amend the Advisory Neighborhood Commissions Act of  
4 1975 to extend the deadline for the Council to enact legislation adjusting the boundaries  
5 of ANC areas and single-member districts to be effective for the November 2022 general  
6 election.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this  
8 act may be cited as the “Advisory Neighborhood Commission Redistricting Deadline Extension  
9 Emergency Amendment Act of 2022”.

10 Sec. 2. Section 3(a)(1) of the Redistricting Procedure Act of 1981, effective March 16,  
11 1982 (D.C. Law 4-87; D.C. Official Code § 1-1041.02(a)(1)) is amended by striking the number  
12 “90” and inserting the number “95” in its place.

13 Sec. 3. Section 4(b) of the Advisory Neighborhood Commissions Act of 1975, effective  
14 October 10, 1975 (D.C. Law 1-21; D.C. Official Code § 1-309.03(b)) is amended by striking the  
15 number “180” and inserting the number “120” in its place.

16 Sec. 4. Fiscal impact statement.

17           The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement of the Budget Director as the fiscal impact  
18 statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975, approved  
19 October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).

20           Sec. 5. Effective date.

21           This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the  
22 Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), and shall remain in effect for no longer than  
23 90 days, as provided for emergency acts of the Council of the District of Columbia in section  
24 412(a) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 788;  
25 D.C. Official Code § 1-204.12(a)).
