IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

---

1 To amend, on a temporary basis, the Redistricting Procedure Act of 1981 to extend the deadline  
2 for submission of ward task force reports on the redistricting of ANC areas and single-  
3 member districts, and to amend the Advisory Neighborhood Commissions Act of 1975 to  
4 extend the deadline for the Council to enact legislation adjusting the boundaries of ANC  
5 areas and single-member districts to be effective for the November 2022 general election.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this  
7 act may be cited as the “Advisory Neighborhood Commission Redistricting Deadline Extension  
8 Temporary Amendment Act of 2022”.

9 Sec. 2. Section 3(a)(1) of the Redistricting Procedure Act of 1981, effective March 16,  
10 1982 (D.C. Law 4-87; D.C. Official Code § 1-1041.02(a)(1)) is amended by striking the number  
11 “90” and inserting the number “95” in its place.

12 Sec. 3. Section 4(b) of the Advisory Neighborhood Commissions Act of 1975, effective  
13 October 10, 1975 (D.C. Law 1-21; D.C. Official Code § 1-309.03(b)) is amended by striking the  
14 number “180” and inserting the number “120” in its place.

15 Sec. 4. Fiscal impact statement.

16           The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement of the Budget Director as the fiscal impact  
17 statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975, approved  
18 October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).

19           Sec. 5. Effective date.

20           (a) This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by  
21 the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of congressional review  
22 as provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December  
23 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of  
24 Columbia Register.

25           (b) This act shall expire after 225 days of its having taken effect.
