On Monday, January 24, 2022, Councilmember Kenyan R. McDuffie, Chairperson of the Committee on Business and Economic Development and Councilmember Mary Cheh, Chairperson of the Committee on Transportation and the Environment will hold a joint public roundtable to consider the following measures:

- Proposed Resolution 24-0552, the “Plenary Infrastructure DC, LLC Bonds Project (DC Smart Lighting) Approval Resolution of 2022”
- CA24-0368, a Proposed Multiyear Contract with Plenary Infrastructure DC to Design, Finance, Construct, Install, and Maintain Upgrades to the District’s Streetlight Network

Proposed Resolution 24-0552 would authorize the District of Columbia to issue up to \$160 million in revenue bonds to assist PIDC (DC Smart Lighting) in the financing, refinancing, or reimbursing

of costs associated with the DC Smart Lighting Project, which is an authorized project pursuant to section 490 of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act.

CA24-0368 would authorize the District to enter into a \$309 million, 15-year fixed-price contract with PIDC to update the District's streetlight network.

The Committees invite the public to testify remotely or submit written testimony. The record for this revenue bond measure will close at 5:00 p.m. on Monday, January 24, 2022. The record for the contract will close at 5:00 p.m. on February 7, 2022.
