**RE:** Request to Agendize Measures for the February 1, 2022 Legislative Meeting

**DATE:** January 27, 2022

I request that the following measures be included on the agenda for the February 1, 2022 Regular Legislative Meeting.

- Expanded Eligibility to Receive Free COVID-19 Services Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2022;
- Expanded Eligibility to Receive Free COVID-19 Services Emergency Act of 2022; and
- Expanded Eligibility to Receive Free COVID-19 Services Temporary Act of 2022.

This legislation expands eligibility to receive free COVID-19 services, such as testing kits, testing services, vaccinations, and boosters, to any person who lives, works, or attends an institution of higher learning in the District.

The COVID-19 virus does not distinguish between residents and non-residents who live, work, or attend an institution of higher learning in the District. The purpose of this emergency and temporary legislation is to remove barriers that prevent persons who live, work, and attend a college or university in the District, from receiving the services that the District offers, in order to slow and stop the spread.
