




30 WHEREAS, Woodrow Wilson High school is a public high school in Washington, DC
31 that welcomes young people and empowers them in an academically rigorous, diverse, and
32 supportive learning environment;

34 WHEREAS, Woodrow Wilson High School supports student-athletes on and off the field
35 to be successful in all that they do;

37 WHEREAS, the Woodrow Wilson High School varsity women’s volleyball team plays in
38 the DC Interscholastic Athletic Association;

40 WHEREAS, the Woodrow Wilson High School varsity women’s volleyball team
41 finished 1st in the DCIAA standings for the 2021-2022 season;

43 WHEREAS, the Woodrow Wilson High School varsity women’s volleyball team is the
44 first public high school to win the DC State Athletic Association volleyball championship;

46 WHEREAS, Coach Perette Arrington has spent 22 years with the Woodrow Wilson High
47 School women’s volleyball program;

49 WHEREAS, the Tigers won 23 matches this season, a testament to the team’s consistent
50 efforts, hard work, and dedication to their sport;

52 WHEREAS, Coach Perette Arrington was named Co-Coach of the Year for the
53 Washington Post’s 2021 Fall All-Metropolitan Volleyball Team;

55 WHEREAS, Senior Summer Campbell was named DCIAA Player of the Year and
56 DCSAA State Championship Most Valuable Player;

58 WHEREAS, Woodrow Wilson High School had two players named to the All-
59 Metropolitan 2021 Team; and

61 WHEREAS, Woodrow Wilson High School faced Georgetown Day School on
62 November 12, 2021 at the DC State Athletic Association Championship and, in a five-game
63 match, won the championship.
