25	December 3, 2020 (D.C. Law 23-149; D.C. Official Code § 2-281.01 et seq.) ("2020 act"), which
26	established the Equity Impact Fund to be managed by a fund manager selected by the Mayor,
27	with the initial funding of the fund of \$1.25 million to be provided by the Deputy Mayor for
28	Planning and Economic Development ("DMPED") for the purpose of aiding and investing in
29	eligible businesses that otherwise lack access to capital. Funds were put in DMPED's Fiscal
30	Year 2021 budget for this purpose.
31	(b) In Spring 2021, the District enacted emergency and temporary legislation to amend
32	the 2020 act to provide that the selected fund manager will establish as well as manage the
33	Equity Impact Fund and to clarify that the initial funding of \$1.25 million provided by DMPED,
