A PROPOSED RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To declare the existence of an emergency with respect to the need to approve Modification Nos. 3, 4, 5, and 6 to Contract No. DCKA-2021-C-0014 with Conduent State & Local Solutions, Inc. to provide management services for the District of Columbia’s parking meter assets and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under that contract.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the “Modification Nos. 3, 4, 5, and 6 to Contract No. DCKA-2021-C-0014 with Conduent State & Local Solutions, Inc. Approval and Payment Authorization Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2022”.

Sec. 2. (a) There exists an immediate need to approve Modification Nos. 3, 4, 5, and 6 to Contract No. DCKA-2021-C-0014 with Conduent State & Local Solutions, Inc., to provide management services for the District of Columbia’s parking meter assets, and to authorize payment for the goods and services received and to be received under the contract.

(b) By Modification No. 3, the Office of Contracting and Procurement, on behalf of the District Department of Transportation, exercised a partial option of option period

34 one of Contract No. DCKA-2021-C-0014 for the period December 20, 2021 through
35 January 19, 2022 in the not-to-exceed amount of \$840,775.09.

36 (c) Modification No. 4 exercised another partial option for the period January 20,
37 2022 through January 26, 2022 in the amount of \$159,223.

38 (d) Modification No. 5 extended the option period through March 5, 2022 at no
39 additional cost.

40 (e) Modification No. 6 is now necessary to exercise the remainder of option
41 period one through June 19, 2022 and increase the total not-to-exceed amount for option
42 period one to \$5,044,650.53.

43 (f) Council approval is necessary since this will increase the value of the contract
44 by more than \$1 million during a 12-month period.

45 (g) Approval is necessary to allow the continuation of these vital services.
46 Without this approval, Conduent State & Local Solutions, Inc. cannot be paid for goods
47 and services provided in excess of \$1 million for the period December 20, 2021 through
48 June 19, 2022.

49 Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the
50 circumstances enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it
51 necessary that the Modification Nos. 3, 4, 5, and 6 to Contract No. DCKA-2021-C-0014
52 with Conduent State & Local Solutions, Inc. Approval and Payment Authorization
53 Emergency Act of 2022 be adopted after a single reading.

54 Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
