19	RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this
20	resolution may be cited as the "Hotel Enhanced Cleaning and Notice of Service Disruption
21	Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2022."
22	Sec 2. There is an immediate need to authorize the Mayor to issue regulations to establish
23	requirements for cleaning and maintenance of District of Columbia hotels and motel rooms and
24	to establish standards for public notice of lodging establishment service disruptions.
25	Sec. 3. (a) Throughout the COVID-19 pandemic, we have seen an increased need to
26	protect the safety of our residents, domestic and international visitors to the District of Columbia,
27	and our hospitality workers through, among other things, enhanced cleaning protocols.
28	(b) During the pandemic, most hotels and motels implemented enhanced cleaning of
29	guest rooms and shared areas to limit the spread of COVID-19. Some hotels and motels,
30	however, suspended or lessened the frequency with which they provided cleaning services
31	leaving staff and patrons at risk of contracting COVID-19.

(c) The recovery of the tourism industry is vital to our economic recovery, but some
visitors are surprised that some hotels and motels are not offering daily cleaning services. As we
begin to see a return to pre-pandemic tourism levels, it is imperative for both safety and
consumer protections that guests be provided routine and enhanced housekeeping and
maintenance of communal spaces in hotels and motels unless the guest opts out of cleanings.

- (d) Lastly, hotel and motel patrons should have the security and assurance of knowing that the hotel or motel is abiding by its agreement to provide safe, secure, and comfortable accommodations.
- Sec. 4. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the circumstances enumerated in section 3 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that the Hotel Enhanced Cleaning and Notice of Service Disruption Emergency Act of 2022 be approved on an emergency basis.
- Sec. 5. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
