19	RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this
20	resolution may be cited as the "Executive Director of the Criminal Code Reform Commission
21	Jinwoo Park Appointment Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2022".
22	Sec. 2. (a) The Criminal Code Reform Commission ("Commission") is an independent
23	agency responsible for submitting to the Mayor and Council recommendations for
24	comprehensive criminal code reform, among other duties.
25	(b) Richard Schmechel has served as the Commission's Executive Director since the
26	Commission was established on October 8, 2016, and Mr. Schmechel provided notice of his
27	intent to resign from his position effective March 26, 2022.
28	(c) Under section 3122(c)(1) of the Fiscal Year 2017 Budget Support Act of 2016,
29	effective October 8, 2016 (D.C. Law 21-160; D.C. Official Code § 3-151(c)(1)), the
30	Commission's Executive Director shall be appointed by Chairman of the Council, subject to the
31	approval of the majority of the Council.

- (d) Pursuant to that statutory authority, on April 5, 2022, Chairman Phil Mendelson
 appointed Jinwoo Park to serve as the Commission's Executive Director.
- 34 (e) Mr. Park currently serves as Acting Executive Director of the Commission. Prior to 35 assuming that position, he served as a Senior Attorney Advisor with the Commission since its 36 inception, and previously worked with its predecessor agency as part of the Sentencing and 37 Criminal Code Revision Commission.
- 38 (f) Mr. Park has had a broad range of responsibilities during his tenure at CCRC. He had 39 direct responsibility for revising the statutes for many of the District's most serious criminal 40 offenses, including laws related to murder, kidnapping, and robbery.
 - (g) Given the recent resignation of former Executive Director Richard Schmechel, there is an immediate need for the Council to approve Mr. Park's appointment as Executive Director of the Criminal Code Reform Commission.
- Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the circumstances enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that the Executive Director of the Criminal Code Reform Commission Jinwoo Park Emergency Appointment Resolution of 2022 be adopted on an emergency basis.
- 48 Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
